EDAN LINCS REFUGE RESIDENTS RADIO PRODUCTION

Residents from EDAN Lincs refuge have recently taken part in a programme of workshops working weekly over a four-month period with Taylor Made Arts, an organisation that uses arts to engage with a variety of community groups. The workshops aim to develop confidence, self-esteem, and communication skills through the creation of an audio play and was funded by the National Lottery. Eleven people took took part in the project, which involved working with creative writers, facilitators and actors. The resulting short audio play, "Christmas, sort of, kind of, but a little bit different" shares many parallels with the women's lives and saw Mrs Claus and the elves saving the day! 


