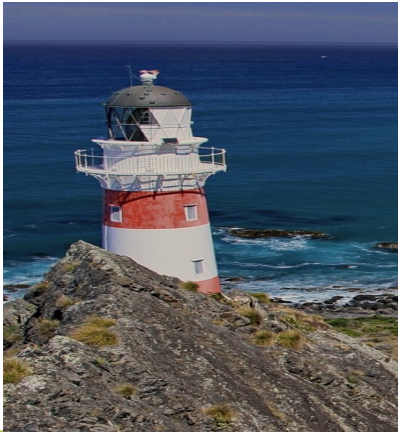




EDAN Lincs Newsletter – September 2021

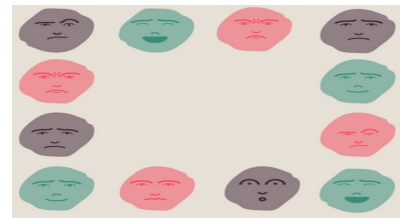
Thank you to 2 Lincolnshire Police cohorts for raising £2,500 undertaking active challenges and clearing up the streets in Skegness
